Executive Summary

The purpose of producing the feature film Art House Conspiracies (Crime/Drama) is to bring this product to an established genre audience and present the brand franchise for future Art House Conspiracies movies. An upscale budget with a list actors is ideal. But an unnecessarily big budget makes recoupment slower. I expect to bring a realistic balance to production. The artistic vision is a strong concept needing quality directorial skills as well as stunts and CGI. One of the challenges is to show the exciting way John's unique mind puts together all the pieces. This requires animation to illustrate his unique vision making. Symbolic representation as well as surreal interpretations are key in telling this story. The back and forth between his perceiving clues and digesting them into his case view, frames the process.

Of course, the relationship between John and Kwon is at the center. They are inseparable. Even when John has a romantic interlude with Diaz, the event is filtered through Kwon's interpretation and approval. The fast-paced action is aided by Kwon's physicality and influence on John to step up his ability to participate.

There is a strong opportunity in this project to include a wider audience interested in art as well as murder mysteries.

The location of the New York City area is very advantageous in creating an art subculture for this story. The city is the art center of the world. Locations abound. In addition, production services at a world class skill level are also readily available. The expectation of individuality with artistic choice, makes for flare in wardrobe and makeup opportunities.

With attention to the appropriate stunts and special effects, I believe this story will come to life with a strong cast of memorable characters. The crime/drama genre always has the advantage of strong motivations and the need for justice. Our movie also appeals to the need to overcome greed and brutality in the search for truth. Our villains have depths and justifications for their twisted values, but in our story as in life they are defined by their choices. I look forward to working with the cast and crew on this project which has come to represent a new standard.



Like WIND RIVER

The main character has special abilities making insights and reactions to events extremely effective. His loose association with the official law permits independent action. The operating concept of justice is a product of his individual worldview. As a consultant, he advises law enforcement. Similar to the character in Wind River whose sympathies are with the Native Americans who are victimized, John's sympathies are with the artists who are similarly victimized.


Like Murder on the Orient Express (2017)

Overview:

The projects above are successful a list movies. Big name actors and directors provide a big opportunity at the box office.

The Informer (2019), Budget \$60,000,000, Gross (World) \$2,927,708

The informer did not do as well at the box office. A good movie, good cast, well made. However, there are no guarantees at the box office. I understand it did much better on Netflix.

Costs of production are way up for studio projects. However, independent movie makers continue to adapt with low budget projects. There has never been a greater demand for quality feature film content.

Overview Film Revenue Package:

- 1. Filmmaker raises money for pre-production, shooting and post-production costs of the movie (the "Budget") from various individual and institutional investors ("Investors.")
- 2. None of the investors receive a return on their investment ("ROI") until all items in the Budget (i.e., all budgeted expenses for the film, including deferred compensation to director, producers, staff, sales agents, and other participants in the film) have been paid in full.
- 3. All income from all sources (e.g., box office revenues, DVD sales, license fees from TV stations) is paid out as follows:
- (a) Distributors of the film deduct their fees and costs off the top of all distribution revenues "Gross Receipts." Gross Receipts less these distribution fees and costs is paid to the film producer.
- (b) Producer must first make good on any items contained in the Budget that have not been met and are paid in full, on a pro rata basis.
- (c) Producer next repays Investors who are repaid the full amount of their actual investment, with interest, on a pro rata basis.
- (d) Investors who are also entitled to "back-end" compensation from the Net Proceeds of the film receive a further ROI, on a pro rata basis, out of the "Investor's Share" of the Net Proceeds. The Investor's Share is typically defined as 50% of the total Net Proceeds. The other 50% of the Net Proceeds goes to the producer (the "Producer's Share"). Any talent and other non-investor third parties who have been promised a back-end share in the movie are paid their percentage out of the "Producer's Share."

What do we want from our movie?

We want to make an excellent movie and realize a healthy profit.

How will we get it?

A high-quality product is a necessity for the success of the production. River plans to use either Arri, or Sony Venice 2 camera shooting aspect ratio 2.39:1. Known as widescreen cinema format. Director of photography and Steadicam operator are key to principle photography. Fortunately, River, a long-time cinematographer, brings expert overview to the shoot. Stunts and special visual effects must be excellent. There is no cheap shortcut. Hair and makeup are also essential for our talent to be camera ready. A drama coach working with director and relevant players can make for smoother takes. The best way to gain respect and loyalty from our audience is to earn it.

Marketing Plan:

In addition to the use of social media (including Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, etc.), film festivals, and our promotional campaigns will promote the film and garner press coverage. AFM's presence assures good word of mouth recognition and potential new distributors. We are searching for the appropriate sales agent.



I'm not familiar with the latest pop music and will have to get a consultant to see if any might be appropriate for our use.

Part of producing for the soundtrack involves going through endless lists. Then, you have to listen to all the work included on those lists. Then, you have to get the legal rights.



The artists' studios are in CT, CA, or NY. They also attend open studios, art openings, private parties, clubs, and other events of interest in an unofficial capacity.

Biography is a romantic comedy of errors. When a gallery director decides to promote his artist with a biography, the clash between the artist and biographer follows. These strong-willed opponents are complicated by a ghost writer and mistaken perceptions on everybody's part.



Action adventure punctuates the high stakes involved in handing over power. 


